STOP WORK ORDER

This case came beforeMary Ellen McQueeney Lally, Esq., Hearing Officer designated by the Director of the Rhode Island Department of Labor and Training, pursuant to Title 28 Chapter 36 Section 15 of the Rhode Island General Laws on a Stop Work Order Show Cause Hearing Notice issued by the Division of Workers' Compensation to JS INTERIORS CONSTRUCTION INC (the "employer").

Upon hearing thereon, the following findings of fact are made:

- 1. There is at least one employee presently working for the employer, thereby requiring that the employer maintain current workers' compensation insurance in accordance with Chapters 29-38 inclusive of Title 28 of the Rhode Island General Laws.
- 2. The employer does not have current workers' compensation insurance coverage.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ordered:

- 1. That, pursuant to Title 28 Chapter 36 Section 15(e)(1), the employer immediately suspend the operation of its business and remain suspended until the employer provides satisfactory proof of workers' compensation insurance to the Director.
- 2. That in the event the employer fails to comply with this Order, the matter shall be referred to the Department of Attorney General for criminal prosecution pursuant to Title 28 Chapter 36 Section 15(a) of the Rhode Island General Laws.
